

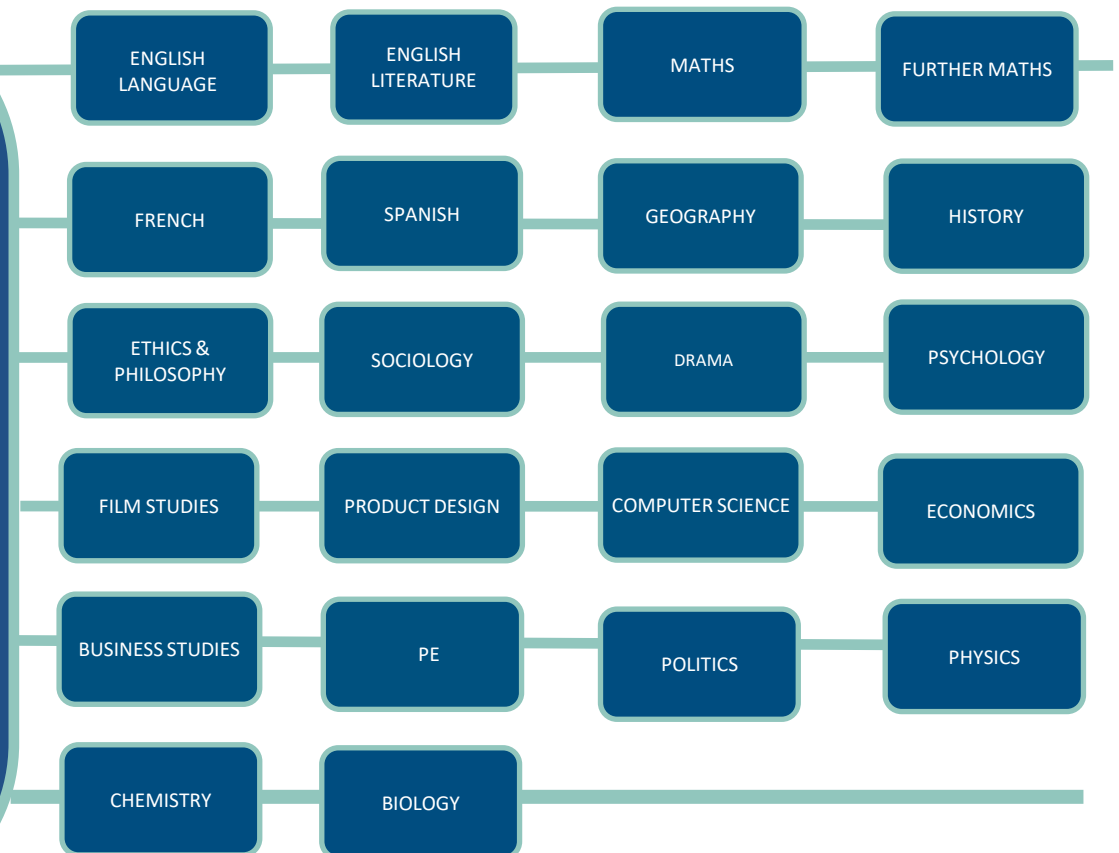
# Year 12 Mock Examinations: Revision Guide
