SF02	Become a School Community Leader Student must adopt the role of a School Community Leader outlined on the Student Leadership visual.	HOH
SF03	Become a School Improvement Leader Mentor Student must adopt the role of School Improvement Leader Mentor outlined on the Student Leadership visual.	HOH
SF04	Play for a school sports team Student must play for a King Alfred's sports team of their choice.	PE staff
SF05	Participate in a school event Student must take part in a school event, this could include house competitions, enrichment talks or workshops.	Event staff
SF06	Take part in a dance, music or drama performance Student must take part in one of the dance, music or drama performances that King Alfred's host in an academic year.	Lead staff
SF07	Gain a prize at school or within the community Student must gain a prize in a competition outside of school and provide their tutor with evidence.	Tutor
SF08	Achieve above 97% attendance in two termly cycles Student must achieve 97% attendance or above for two termly cycles e.g. September - April or January - July	Tutor
SF09	Attend a school trip, visit, activity or school event Student must attend an optional school trip, visit or school event of their choice including KAAEP talks and workshops.	Trip staff
SF10	Be part of KATS for one year Student must be part of the King Alfred's Talented Sportspeople for an academic year.	Lead staff
SF11	Achieve the department principle award Student must achieve a department principle award from any of the school's faculties.	Head of department
SF12	Become a Sixth Form Charity Rep Student must become a Sixth Form Charity Rep and assist with the fundraising within the school.	HOH
SF13	Complete the EPQ Student must complete the EPQ	Lead staff
SF14	Read 5 books from your subject reading list plus 25 other books from 5 genres in one academic year Student must read 5 books from their academic reading list as well as 25 books from 5 genres within one academic year.	Lead staff/Tutor
SF15	Receive a Headteachers commendation Students must achieve a commendation from the headteacher.	Headteacher
SF16	Achieve 200 positive points in one academic year Students must achieve 200 house points in one academic year.	Tutor
SF17	Receive two positive communications home during an academic year Students must receive two positive communications home in an academic year. This includes postcards or phone calls.	Tutor
SF18	Complete a sustained period of work experience/ volunteering work Students must complete a sustained period of work experience/volunteering work over a minimum of 6 months.	Tutor
