### CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT AWARD SCHEME

#### Silver Challenge Descriptions



S01	<b>Participate in electives for two termly cycles</b> Student must participate in an elective for two big terms e.g. September - April or January - July	Elective staff
S02	<b>Take on a lead role as a School Community Leader</b> Student must adopt one of the School Community Leader roles outlined on the Student Leadership visual.	HOH
S03	<b>Take on a Tutor Lead role as a School Improvement Leader</b> Student must adopt one of the School Improvement Leader roles outlined on the Student Leadership visual.	HOH
S04	<b>Play for two school sports teams in one year</b> Student must play for two King Alfred's sports teams of their choice.	PE staff
S05	<b>Take part in at least two House events over a school year</b> Student must take part in two house competitions. E.g. photography competition, Christmas cake competition etc.	HOH
S06	<b>Take part in more than one dance, music or drama performance</b> Student must take part in two of the dance, music or drama performances that King Alfred's host in an academic year.	Lead staff
S07	<b>Gain a prize in a competition outside of school</b> Student must gain a prize in a competition of their choice outside of school and provide their tutor with evidence.	Tutor
S08	<b>Achieve 100% attendance in two termly cycles</b> Student must achieve 100% attendance for two big terms e.g. September – April or January - July	Tutor
S09	<b>Demonstrate the school principles on a school trip, visit, activity or school event</b> Student must attend an optional school trip, visit or school event and demonstrate the school principles by writing a short reflection	Trip staff
S10	<b>Be part of the KATS programme for two years</b> Student must be part of the King Alfred's Talented Sportspeople for two academic years.	Lead staff
S11	<b>Achieve a department principle award</b> Student must achieve a department principle award from any of the school's faculties. This cannot be the same as the one received for the Bronze award.	Head of Department
S12	<b>Raise money for charity in two charity events</b> Student must raise money for charity in two events and provide their tutor with evidence.	Tutor
S13	<b>Read 8 books from at least 4 different 'Read Your Way challenges</b> Students must read 8 books from at least 4 different 'Read Your Way' reading challenges across different subjects.	Lead staff
S14	<b>Write &amp; submit reviews on at least 10 books</b> Students must write a book review in their tutor journals on 10 different books that they have read over the year.	Lead staff/Tutor
S15	<b>Receive a Headteacher's commendation</b> Students must achieve a commendation from the headteacher. This must be different to the one received for bronze.	Headteacher
S16	<b>Achieve 150 positive points during one academic year</b> Students must receive 150 house points in one academic year. This must be a different year to the bronze challenge.	Tutor
S17	<b>Receive three positive communications home during an academic year</b> Students must receive three positive communications home in an academic year. This includes postcards or phone calls. These cannot include the positive communications received for the bronze award.	Tutor
S18	<b>Complete 20 hours of successful work experience/volunteering work</b> Students must complete 20 hours of volunteering work and provide their tutor with evidence of completion.	Tutor
S19	<b>Complete Bronze DofE</b> Students must complete all sections of the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award.	DofE staff
S20	<b>Review Personal Development Log and set a personal goal(s)</b> Students must review their Personal Development Log on Epraise and set personal goal(s) for the next academic year.	Tutor
