Bronze Challenge Descriptions



B01	Participate in an elective for one termly cycle Student must participate in an elective for an entire big term e.g. September - December, January - April or April - July.	Elective staff
B02	Become an active School Community Leader participant Student must adopt one of the School Community Leader roles outlined on the Student Leadership visual.	HOH
B03	Become an active School Improvement participant Regularly engage in tutor time discussions around school improvement	HOH
B04	Play for a school sports team Student must play for a King Alfred's sports team of their choice.	PE staff
B05	Take part in one house event over a school year Student must take part in a voluntary house competition. E.g. photography competition, Christmas cake competition etc.	HOH
B06	Take part in a dance, music or drama performance Student must take part in one of the dance, music or drama performances that King Alfred's host in an academic year.	Lead staff
B07	Participate in a competition outside of school Student must take part in a competition of their choice outside of school and provide their tutor with evidence.	Tutor
B08	Achieve 100% attendance in one termly cycle Student must achieve 100% attendance for an entire big term e.g. September - December, January - April or April - July.	Tutor
B09	Attend a school trip, visit, activity or school event Student must attend an optional school trip, visit or school event of their choice including KAAEP talks and workshops.	Trip staff
B10	Be part of the KATS programme for one year Student must be part of the King Alfred's Talented Sportspeople for an academic year.	Lead staff
B11	Achieve a department principle award Student must achieve a department principle award from any of the school's faculties.	Head of Department
B12	Raise money for charity in one event Student must raise money for charity in one event and provide their tutor with evidence.	Tutor
B13	Read 5 books from at least 2 different 'Read Your Way' challenges Students must read 5 books from at least 2 different 'Read Your Way' reading challenges across different subjects.	Lead staff
B14	Achieve 'Word Millionaire' Students must become a Word Millionaire.	Lead staff
B15	Receive a Headteacher's commendation Students must achieve a commendation from the headteacher.	Headteacher
B16	Achieve 100 positive points in one academic year Students must achieve 100 house points in one academic year.	Tutor
B17	Receive two positive communications home during an academic year Students must receive two positive communications home in an academic year. This includes postcards or phone calls.	Tutor
B18	Complete 10 hours of volunteering work Students must complete 10 hours of volunteering work and provide their tutor with evidence of completion.	Tutor
B19	Complete the sponsored walk Students must successfully complete the sponsored walk.	Event staff/Tutor
B20	Create Personal Development Log and review termly Students must create a Personal Development Log on Epraise and review their log termly for an academic year.	Tutor
