Gold Challenge Descriptions



G01	Participate in a revision-based elective for at least one term Student must participate in a revision-based elective for an entire big term e.g. September - December.	Elective staff
G02	Take on a lead role as a School Community Leader Mentor Student must adopt the role of a School Community Leader Mentor outlined on the Student Leadership visual.	HOH
G03	Take on a Year Lead role as a School Improvement Leader Mentor Student must adopt the role of School Improvement Leader Mentor outlined on the Student Leadership visual.	HOH
G04	Play for three or more school sports teams in one year Student must play for three King Alfred's sports teams of their choice.	PE staff
G05	Take part in at least three House events over a school year Student must take part in three house competitions. E.g. photography competition, Christmas cake competition etc.	HOH
G06	Perform a solo/have a lead role in a dance, music or drama performance Student must perform a solo/have a lead role in one of the dance, music or drama performances that King Alfred's host.	Lead staff
G07	Win a competition outside of school Student must win a prize in a competition outside of school and provide their tutor with evidence.	Tutor
G08	Achieve above 97% attendance all year Student must achieve 97% attendance or above for a whole academic year.	Tutor
G09	Excel in demonstrating the school principles on a school trip, visit, activity or school event Student must attend an optional school trip, visit or school event and demonstrate the school principles by writing a short reflection	Trip staff
G10	Be part of the KATS programme for three years Student must be part of the King Alfred's Talented Sportspeople for three academic years.	Lead staff
G11	Achieve a department principle award Student must achieve a department principle award from any of the school's faculties. This cannot be the same as the one received for the silver award.	Head of Department
G12	Raise money in a charity event outside of school Student must raise money for charity in an event outside of school and provide their tutor with evidence.	Tutor
G13	Read 12 books selected from all 6 'Read Your Way' challenges. Students must read 12 books from at least 6 different 'Read Your Way' reading challenges across different subjects.	Lead staff
G14	Encourage others to read (Reading Partner, Library Volunteer) Students must take on a role which assists in encouraging students to read and develop reading skills.	Lead staff/Tutor
G15	Receive a Headteacher's commendation Students must achieve a commendation from the headteacher. This must be different to the one received for silver.	Headteacher
G16	Achieve 200 positive points during one academic year Students must receive 200 house points in one academic year. This must be a different year to the silver challenge.	Tutor
G17	Receive four positive communications home during an academic year Students must receive four positive communications home in an academic year. This includes postcards or phone calls. These cannot include the positive communications received for the silver award.	Tutor
G18	Complete 30 hours of successful work experience/volunteering work Students must complete 30 hours of volunteering work and provide their tutor with evidence of completion.	Tutor
G19	Complete Silver DofE Students must complete all sections of the Silver Duke of Edinburgh Award.	DofE staff
G20	Review Personal Development Log and complete set goal(s) Students must review their Personal Development Log on Epraise and complete their set goals.	Tutor
