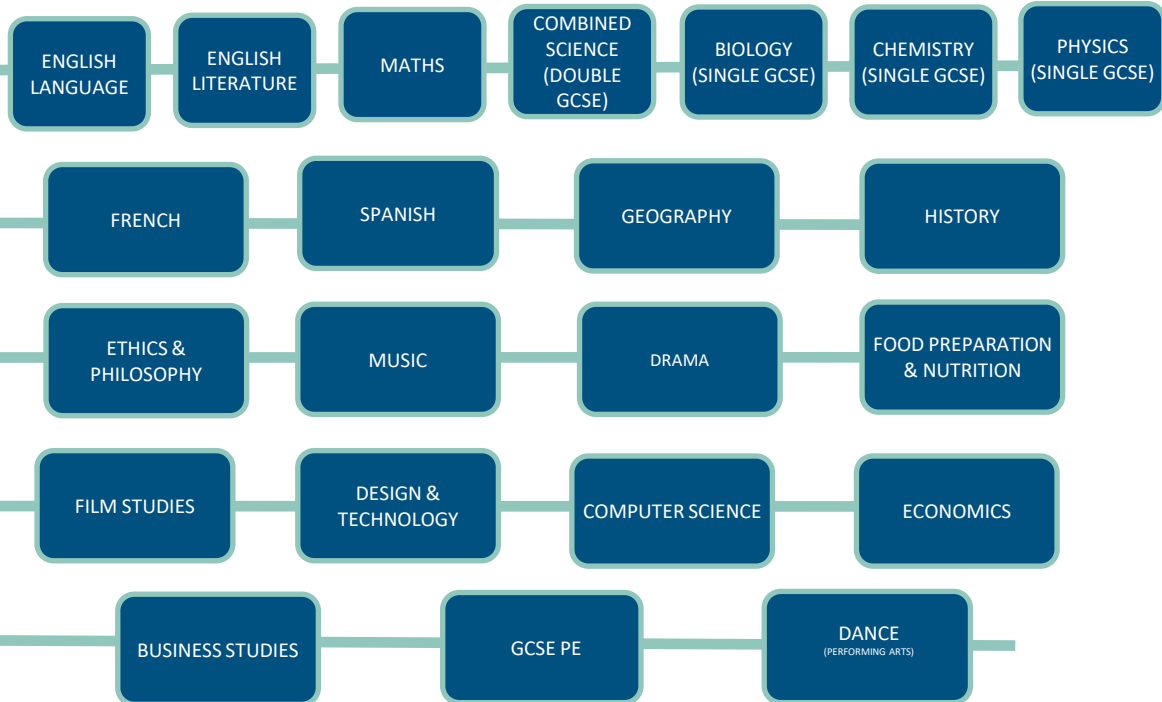


## Examinations: revision lists

From Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November to Monday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2025, Year 11 will have Mock or Mini Mock Examinations in most of their subjects (one or two subjects will have their mocks outside of this window). In order to help our students prepare for these, we have compiled lists of the topics/knowledge students need to revise for each examination. Where appropriate, we have also given advice on key resources that we advise student use to help them revise. Please note, due to coursework demands, there are no mini mocks in the following subjects: Health and Social Care, Art, Textiles and Graphics.

To support students in fulfilling their full potential in exams, we are asking parents/carers to help our young people organise their revision time to ensure they are fully prepared for their mocks.
